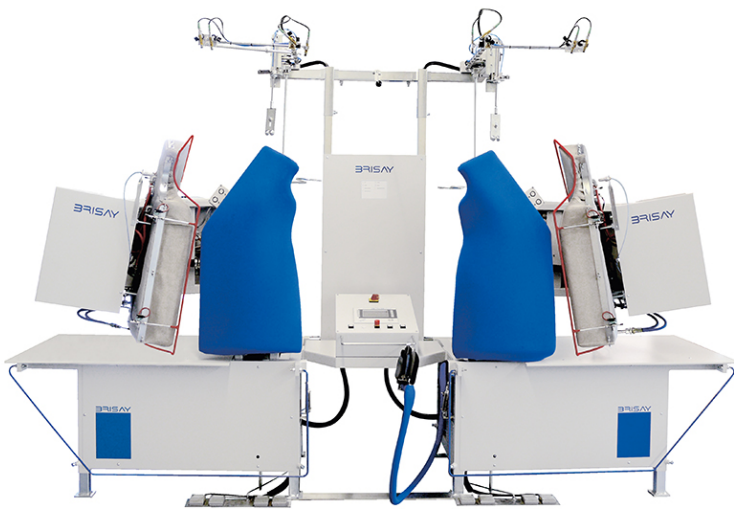


Jacket Front Finish Pressing Machine

BRI 1200/101 Premium

Vertically arranged bucks for high-quality front-part pressing with flexible steam/suction control.



Key Advantages

- **Vertical closing of head bucks:** even pressure distribution, prevents garment displacement, improves quality.
- **Separate steam & suction chambers:** individually process upper/lower front areas; adapts to different fabrics.
- **Lower bucks with 2-step suction:** easier positioning and stable handling.
- **Armhole-area blowing device:** blows away leaked steam to avoid steam marks.
- **5.7" colour touch display:** user-friendly operation and clear visibility.

Buck Arrangement	Vertically arranged bucks (jacket hangs like on a human body)
User Interface	5.7" colour touch display + separate program selection switch
Processing	Head bucks with separate chambers for steam and suction
Handling	Lower bucks with 2-step suction; hanger suspension device
Fabric Protection	Digital distance control to reduce marks/shine; armhole blowing to avoid steam marks
Automation	Intermediate hanging device + automatic program stepping; optional tandem operation

Vertically arranged bucks – finishing benefits

- Jacket hangs on the buck as on a human body
- Alignment of seams, edges and stripes is easier
